Résumé

 \cdot The surveys and their results will assess both, level of maturity, and compliance with the latest

EOSC specifications, with the aim of identifying candidate services and tools that can be offered

trans-nationally.

- \cdot The analysis will offer the state of the art of existing national initiatives and services for computing and data services in the countries involved, and support their consolidation.
- \cdot Creation of full reports, which will be offered in open access modality and in compliance with all
